Learned Counsel for the applicant has prayed for accommodation. This case was instituted in the year 2015 and reply and rejoinder have already been exchanged between the parties and the same are kept on record. Accordingly, we do not find any cogent reason to grant adjournment of hearing. We are inclined to dispose of the instant application on merit.

By referring to the reply submitted on behalf of the state respondents, Mrs. Agarwal, Learned Counsel for the state respondents, contends that the deceased employee Tapan Kumar Mukherjee got all the retirement benefits after his retirement. She further submits that the deceased employee Tapan Kumar Mukherjee disclosed the name of one Aruna Mukherjee as his wife in whose favour family pension has Mr. Mitra. already been granted. the Departmental Representative of respondent AG (A&E), West Bengal has produced the original Pension File to establish that family pension has already been issued in favour of Aruna Mukherjee who happens to be the wife of the deceased employee. It is relevant to point out that the name of Aruna Mukherjee appeared as the wife of the deceased Tapan Kumar Mukherjee in the original PPO issued for grant of pension.

Under the above circumstances, we are of the view that the applicant contracted marriage with deceased Tapan Kumar Mukherjee on May 12, 1988 during the existence of marital
