Submission is that since juniors to the applicant got the benefit of exemption from appearing in the examination and ultimately they were allowed the benefit of scale no.18, being non-functional promotion to the post of Assistant Engineer (Mechanical) in the ratio of 60:40 and as he joined in the post of Assistant Engineer on promotion after rendering six years of satisfactory service at the age of 52 plus years in 2010 and had completed six years of satisfactory service in the year 2016, he may be granted the higher scale of pay.
