It is noted that vide order dated 24.02.2021 both the MA 194 of 2019 and OA 888 of 2018 were directed to be listed on 19.05.2021. However, it is noted thereafter MA 194 of 2019 was not listed; even today MA has not been listed. Therefore, MA 194 of 2019 may be treated as a part of today's list as item no. 13A.

The instant MA has been filed praying for condonation of delay for filing the instant OA. As per the applicant, she had come earlier before this Tribunal in OA No. 2589 of 2005, which was disposed of on 06.04.2006 with a direction to the respondents to treat the original application as representation and disposed of the matter within 4 (four) months. Subsequently, the respondent vide letter dated 14.07.2011 had informed that the claim for the pensionary benefit of the applicant could not be settled due to more than one claimant. However, all papers are sent to the Legal and Law Department for legal opinion for the finalisation of the matter. However, till date, no final decision has been communicated to the applicant, though the applicant submitted representation on 27.01.2017 followed by 14.06.2017. However, no final decision has been communicated to the applicant. Therefore, there is some delay in filing the instant application. The counsel for the applicant has prayed for condonation of delay in filing the original application.
