The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No.638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The prayer in this application is for a direction upon the respondents to reassess the answer key in respect of the selection process for the post of Wireless Operator in West Bengal Police Telecommunications, 2020 most specifically with regard to question no.41 of C series booklet and if it is found that the applicant has been deprived in the selection process due to non-issuance of mark due to wrong answer key prepared by the respondent, in that case 1 mark would be awarded for the same and appointment letter would be issued in favour of the applicant.

The Tribunal finds it difficult to understand what exactly the applicant has prayed for. From the submission of the learned counsel, it is understood that the applicant did not attempt to answer the question no.41 of C Series booklet, but he prays that if his answer is found to be correct, 1(one) mark is to be awarded to him.

Mr. Banerjee, learned counsel has submitted that this examination was held in the year 2020 and the final result has already been published.

The maintainability of this application is seriously doubted by the Tribunal. Since no answer was given to question no.41 of C Series booklet, the question of awarding 1 (one) mark does not arise at all.

In view of the above, the application is dismissed.
