The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5(6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

Mr. Banerjee, learned counsel for the State respondents files a copy UO No. 0232 dated 03.06.2025 issued by the Finance Department, Group P2 and submits that the Finance Department has communicated its views regarding regularisation of the absent period from 17.09.1981 to 31.12.2008. Mr. Banerjee further submits that in terms of the Finance Department's views, the respondent authority will regularise the absent period and settle all admissible dues to the applicant.

In view of the above submission, let respondent no. 2, the Director of Health Services, Department of Health & Family Welfare complete the process of regularisation of the absent period and settle the admissible dues to the applicant expeditiously in accordance with the rules, preferably within four (04) months from the date of communication of this order.
