The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The applicants have filed this application before this Tribunal praying for a direction to the respondent authorities to allow them the benefits of Scale No. 10 from the date of their joining as I.C..D.S. Supervisor. By a joint petition dated 19.09.2019, they had requested the Director, I.C.D.S. Scheme for such benefit. In their representation they have quoted the Hon'ble High Court's order also in Contempt Applications in CCP-41 of 2008 in connection with OA-1446 of 1998 Sheela Bhattacharya Vs. State of West Bengal & Ors.

From the submissions of the learned counsels, the Tribunal finds that such representations filed by those applicants have not been considered and no decision has been taken by the Director, I.C.D.S. Scheme. Mr. Ray, learned counsel submits that if a direction is given to consider the prayers in the representation, the same shall be considered and an order passed as per rules.

Having heard the submissions of the learned counsels, this application is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 3, Director of I.C.D.S., Deptt. of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare to examine the representation filed by the applicants before her on 19.09.2019 praying for granting of Scale No. 10 and pass a speaking and
