The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsel and the learned Departmental representatives for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The applicant has prayed for a direction to the respondent authorities to grant the applicant Family Pension along with other retiral and death benefits of her late husband. The applicant claims to be the wife of the deceased employee, Subhra Sankar Mukherjee, working as a Revenue Officer in the office of SDL & LRO, Barrackpore, North 24 Paraganas, who superannuated on 31.01.2021 and expired on 03.12.2022. Attention has been drawn to a Memo. 116 dated 19.09.2024 by which the SDL & LRO had advised the applicant to submit few relevant documents which would help them to accept her claim to be the wife of the deceased employee.

Mr.G.Haldar, learned counsel submits that all the required documents have already been furnished before the respondent authorities. Ms.R.Sarkar, has indicated that although some documents

have been received, but still few are awaited from the applicant side. Once all the documents have been received, the respondent authority will examine these and take a suitable decision.

From the above wordings, the Tribunal finds that the respondent authorities are in the process of examining the documents and taking a decision in this matter relating to release of Family Pension. At this juncture, the Tribunal does not find it necessary to intervene. Let the applicant side exhaust the remedy available to her in the office of the concerned respondent authorities by submitting relevant documents. Thus, this application is disposed of without passing any orders.
