The counsel for the applicant has submitted that during the pendency of the case, the Sericulture Department has been merged with the Agriculture Department. Therefore, she wants to implead the Secretary, Department of Agriculture, Nabanna as respondent no. 1 (a). Prayer is allowed. The applicant is directed to make appropriate amendment in the cause title during the course of the day.

The instant application has been filed basically praying for compassionate appointment in favour of the applicant. As per the applicant, the father of the applicant died on 25.09.2013. Thereafter, the mother of the applicant submitted an application for compassionate appointment on 06.02.2014 (Annexure-C). However, subsequently, the case of the applicant was regretted by the authority vide impugned order dated 06.01.2017. Being aggrieved with, the applicant has filed the instant application. However, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that during the pendency of the instant application, the Commissioner of Textiles vide his Memo. No. 114/EST/REGL/TEMP 56 # Temp 56 dated 26.10.2018 had asked for certain documents for reconsideration of the case of the applicant. Subsequently, vide Memo. No. 425(2)/Estt. dated 17.07.2019, the Deputy Director, Textiles (Sericulture), Berhampore forwarded the required documents submitted by the applicant to the Joint Director of Textiles (Sericulture), East Zone, Kolkata. However, till date no further communication has been received by the applicant.

During the course of the hearing, the counsel for the applicant has submitted that it would suffice the purpose of the applicant if the

Secretary, Department of Agriculture would be directed to take final decision in this regard within a stipulated period of time treating the application as part of it.

The counsel for the respondent has raised no objection for such consideration.

Heard the parties and perused the records.

Therefore, the respondent no.1 (a), Secretary, Department of Agriculture is directed to take final decision with regard to the compassionate appointment of the applicant treating this OA as part of it as well as taking into consideration the Memo. No. 114/EST/REGL/TEMP 56 # Temp 56 dated 26.10.2018 and Memo. No. 425 (2)/Estt. dated 17.07.2019 and to communicate the same by way of passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the order after granting the applicant an opportunity of hearing.

The applicant is directed to communicate the order along with the copy of the OA and the communication dated 26.10.2018 and 17.07.2019 along with the copy of the petition with annexures to the Secretary, Department of Agriculture.

Accordingly, the OA is **disposed of** with no order as to costs.
