During subsistence of this first marriage, her husband on 07.03.1979 married one Alpana Gorai. On 28.11.1997, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purulia ordered monthly maintenance at the rate Rs.600/- to the applicant by deciding Misc. Case No.47 of 1995. The retired government employee expired on 01.12.2019. The applicant, being the first wife, submitted representations for family pension and other benefits before the authority on 10.01.2020 and 20.01.2020.
