The matter is taken up by the single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 118-WBAT/1E-08/2003 (Pt.-II) dated 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under section 6 (5) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The matter came up for hearing on 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022 when after hearing the learned advocate for the applicant, direction was issued to serve copies of the application and copies of the order dated 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022 on each of the respondents, including the private respondents, and the matter was directed to appear on 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.

The matter appeared on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 when affidavit of service was filed by Mr.A.Maity, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the applicant and the matter was directed to appear under the heading "Admission Hearing" on 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. The matter appeared on 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 when Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned advocate prayed for an adjournment on behalf of Mr.K.Mondal, learned advocate for the applicant and the matter was directed to appear on this date under the heading "Admission Hearing".

Today the matter has appeared under the heading "Admission Hearing". None appears on behalf of the applicant.

Since perusing the application I find that this application was adjourned

on the prayer on behalf of the applicant and as it appears the applicant, inter alia, has prayed for a direction upon the respondents “*to consider the representation dated 12/04/2021, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the private respondent, and proceed to pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law and if the authority finds that concern respondent has not discharged his obligation, as per the law, it would be open for him to withdraw the benefit already extended or to impose such other conditions, as may be found expedient, considering the facts and circumstances of the present case, and also the provision of law.*” considering such fact, the application is disposed of by directing the District Magistrate and Collectorate, Murshidabad, the respondent no. 2 (2) to dispose of the representation dated 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2021, being Annexure – P/C to the application, by passing a reasoned order to be communicated to the parties within fifteen weeks from the date of presentation of a copy of this order after giving an opportunity of hearing to the applicant and to the private respondent no. 2 (3), after making necessary inquiry and after verifying the records.

It is made clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter and all points are kept open to be dealt with by the District Magistrate and Collectorate, Murshidabad.
