Learned counsel for the applicant submits that although the applicant's case for compassionate employment was processed and on the last occasion on 27.11.2008 it was forwarded by the Superintending Engineer (Western Circle-I) to the Director of Personnel and Ex-Officio Chief Engineer-I, I & W D Dte, Kolkata. Despite such a long time, the respondent has neither considered the proposal nor intimated anything to the applicant. Submission is that the respondent may be directed to consider the application of the applicant for compassionate employment and dispose it off at the earliest.

Mr. S.N. Roy submits that there was difficulty in considering his application for compassionate employment due to the fact that his father was a Work Charged employee. However, he became regular employee at later stage.

After hearing both the learned advocates, the matter is disposed of by directing the Respondent No. 2, Director of Personnel & Ex-Officio Chief Engineer-I, Irrigation & Waterways Department, Jalsampad Bhawan, Salt Lake, Kolkata to dispose of the matter within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks as per law and communicate the same to the applicant within a period of two
