The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

On the last date of hearing, the following was recorded: "The applicant was suspended by an order dated 17.02.2020 for being involved in a criminal case no. 61 of 2016 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act. Though the suspended employee has been receiving the subsistence allowance, but Mr. Mustafi argues that neither the suspension has been revoked nor it has been reviewed by the respondent authorities. Further, since the date of suspension on 17.02.2020, no steps have been taken to initiate any disciplinary proceedings against the applicant."

Today, Mr. Mustafi, learned counsel for the applicant submits that such case has already been concluded with acquittal of the applicant. Mr. Mustafi files a copy of the order of Ld. Addl. Dist. & Sessions Judge, Suri, Birbhum. Copy be kept with the record. Mr. Mustafi prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to consider revocation of his suspension order in the light of the fact that the applicant has been acquitted from the criminal case for which he was suspended.
