Submission of Ms. Dey is that despite such appearance and submission of all relevant documents, neither any compassionate appointment has been offered nor any intimation made to the applicant.

Despite service none has appeared on behalf of Respondent No. 1(a) Addl. Chief Secretary, Department of Animal Resources Development Deptt., Respondent No. (2) Addl. Milk Commissioner and Respondent No. (6) The Milk Commissioner and Respondent No. (8) Deputy Secretary, Animal Resources Development Department.
