The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer in this application is for direction to the respondent authorities to release all the legal dues of the applicant in terms of this Tribunal's direction passed in OA 1161 of 2016 dated 20.02.2019. The respondent authorities heard the applicant and passed a reasoned order. In the reasoned order, the applicant was advised to submit all the bills for which he is claiming payment.

Mrs.S.Agarwal, learned counsel informs that though the applicant had submitted the bills, but on scrutiny it was found that some of the bills submitted were not in proper order and some other bills had some discrimination. Mrs.Agarwal further submits that if the proper bills are submitted by the applicant, the same will be considered as per rules.
