The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the order contained in the Notification No. 638-WBAT/2J-15/2016 (Pt.-II) dated 23rd November, 2022 issued in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 5 (6) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

On consent of the learned counsels for the contesting parties, the case is taken up for consideration sitting singly.

The prayer of the applicant for offering an employment under compassionate ground was considered and rejected on the ground that such an application was furnished after more than two years from the date of death of the deceased employee. The husband of the applicant Daman Chandra Soren was a G.D.A. employee at Belpahari, B.P.H.C. had died in harness on 19.08.2007. A plain paper application was submitted before the respondent authorities by the applicant on 12.03.2010 followed by the proforma application on 27.03.2010. Since as per Clause 14(a) of Labour Department's Notification of 251-Emp allows a maximum relaxation of two years, this application was not considered.

Submission of Mr. Banerjee is that as stated in her representation submitted before the respondent authorities on 15.01.2015, due to unfavourable law and order situation in the region, the applicant could not file the application before the respondent authorities within time limit. Mr. Banerjee prays for a direction to the respondent authorities to consider her representation addressed before the Director of Health Services, W.B.
