The matter is taken up by the Single Bench pursuant to the Notification No. 949-WBAT/2J-15/2016 dated 24th December, 2020, issued in exercise of the powers conferred under sub section (6) of Section 5 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

The instant application has been filed praying for implementation of the order dated 27.11.2013 passed in OA-879 of 2011 in the case of Nemai Chandra Saha v. The State of West Bengal & Others. During the course of the hearing, the counsel for the respondent has added that they have not preferred any writ petition against the order. It has further submitted that the counsel for the respondent had taken some steps for implementation of the order dated 27.11.2013, some steps are yet to be taken as per the Tribunal's Order. Therefore, he has prayed for some time for implementation of the said order.

The counsel for the applicant has submitted that she has no objection if the respondent would be granted time to implement the order dated 27.11.2013 within a stipulated period of time.

In view of the above, respondent no. 2 is directed to take appropriate steps for implementation of the order dated 27.11.2013 as directed by this Tribunal in OA-879 of 2011 within a period of 3 (three) months from the date of receipt of the order by way of a reasoned and speaking order and to communicate the same. The concerned Department is directed to take follow up action as per decision of the Finance Department. The entire process should be completed within a period of 4 (four) months from the date of receipt of the order.

Accordingly, the OA is disposed of.
