The applicant has filed this application praying for a direction upon the respondent authorities to consider her application for an appointment under compassionate ground. Sekhar Sarkar, father of the applicant died on 01.01.2010 holding the post of a Lower Division Clerk (LDC) in the Office of B.L. & L.R.O., Raninagar - I, Murshidabad. The applicant after a long lapse of time on 27.03.2025 preferred a representation before the B.L. & L.R.O., Raninagar -I, Murshidabad praying for an appointment to her under the compassionate appointment Scheme. The long gap of furnishing such an application by the applicant has been responded by Mr. Sanyal with the reason that the applicant was a minor at the time of death of her father. Only after attaining the age of employment, she preferred this application. The date of birth of the applicant in her Madhyamik Pariksha Certificate of 2022 shows 06<sup>th</sup> November, 2005. At the time of death of her father, she was around four years old.

The matter is admitted.
