The contention of the applicant is that she is the unmarried daughter of the deceased employee and she submitted application for grant of family pension. On consideration of the materials on record, we are not in a position to form opinion whether all relevant documents have been filed by the applicant for passing the order of release of family pension and arrears of family pension, if any.</p> <p>Under the above circumstances, we direct the applicant to file all necessary documents and to fill up prescribed format, if not already done, within a period of two weeks from this date. The respondent no. 4 , the Superintendent cum Vice Principal, Medical College & Hospital is directed to resubmit family pension claim of the applicant with all relevant documents after taking necessary approval from the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal, if necessary, before the A.G.(A&E)W.B. within a period of fourteen weeks from the date of communication of the order.</p> <p>With the above direction, the Original Application is disposed of.</p> <p>Let a plain copy of the order be supplied to</p>
