Unfortunately Dhruba Bagchi had expired on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2014 leaving behind the applicant as sole heir as stated in the petition. It has been stated that Dhruba Bagchi was a bachelor and had never married. However, one Mumpy Das, the private respondent no. (vi) had "attempted to create claim of monetary and other benefits in her favour through a forged document that is forged Marriage Certificate that shows that she was allegedly married to the son of the applicant on 17.12.2007." (paragraph 4 of the application). According to the applicant since she has filed a representation on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2017 before the Registrar General of Marriage, Kolkata, as evident from page 25 of the application, appropriate order may be passed for staying the grant of monetary benefits in favour of said Mumpy Das. Mrs. H.A. Begum, learned advocate for the applicant, submits that appropriate order may be passed staying the grant of monetary benefits by the State to the said Mumpy Das. Mr. G.P.
