Mitra, Departmental Representative.</p> <p>Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we are of the view that Nabanita Sur, the daughter of the deceased Government employee Samar Kumar Dutta is a necessary party in the present original application. Moreover, the judgment and decree passed in Mat. Suit No. 795 of 2002 needs to be produced by the applicant to ascertain whether he was the wife of the deceased Government employee on the date of his death for the purpose of receiving family pension.</p> <p>Under the above circumstances, we direct the applicant to implead Nabanita Sur as the respondent in the original application by way of amendment of cause title of the original application within two weeks after expiry of Puja Vacation. The applicant is further directed to serve copy of the original application on the added respondent Nabanita Sur by speed post or by registered post within a period of 4 (four) weeks after expiry of Puja Vacation</p>
