According to the applicant, after the death of her father she applied before the authority for compassionate appointment. However, she was not found fit for the post of constable and subsequently vide message dated 22.03.2016, it was intimated to her that the department had asked for willingness for appointment as General Duty Assistant (Group - D) post under Health and Family Welfare Department and if she is willing to accept that she has to give her willingness, wherein her name was at the serial No. 2. In response to that, she submitted her willingness on 28.03.2016. But till date, no decision with regard to her compassionate appointment has been communicated to her. Thereafter she submitted one application u/s 3(c) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 but she has not received any information. Being aggrieved with, she has filed the instant application.</i></p>
